Aloomba State School will receive

\$30,824

This funding will be used to

- Support every student to meet and exceed the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in literacy and numeracy for their year level or have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs
- Ensure 80% of Prep students meet the target of (Performance Management) PM Level 9 by the end of 2019
- Maintain percentage of students in National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) Upper Two Bands for Year 3 Reading - 63.6% in 2018
- Have 100% of Year 3 and 5 students exceed the NMS in literacy and numeracy in 2019.

Our initiatives include

- Using a continuous process, including regular individual testing in focus areas:
 - reading – PM Benchmarks, sight word levels, home reading levels
 - writing and numeracy to assess students' current performance and reassess students to monitor improvement. (Evidence- Hattie, J, *Visible Learning for Teacher*)
- Pretesting and using evidence based data to target students who require support or extension in reading in order to meet grade level targets
- Improving teacher and teacher aide capability through focused coaching and professional development in reading and writing to improve student performance (Seven Steps Writing; Anita Archer - Explicit Teaching)
- Providing teacher and teacher Aide support targeting 'at risk' students – daily reading and sight words and small group literacy sessions with a teacher
- Providing Writing Extension Program for Year 2-6 students.
