Whooping Cough

We have been contacted by the Cairns Tropical Health Unit informing us of cases of Whooping Cough (at our school) that were diagnosed during the school holidays. If your child is coughing please get them tested as a matter of urgency. If Whooping cough is diagnosed, recommended exclusion at school is as follows:-



Exclude until 5 days after starting appropriate antibiotics or for 21 days from onset of cough. Exclusion may apply for those in contact with the infected person.

Headlice

Headlice has found its way to Aloomba School. We are asking that all parents examine their child's hair for signs of lice infestation. The lice themselves are often hard to find as they move around on the head. Therefore, you should be looking for the eggs or nits. These appear as tiny silvery white specks attached to the hair shaft near the scalp. If your child has contracted head lice do not be alarmed, although the condition is unpleasant, it is easily treated. As head lice are highly contagious it is suggested that you examine and treat all members of the family at the same time. It's a good idea to check your child/ren's hair every weekend, if possible Friday afternoon so you have plenty of time to treat it.
