Crossing Supervision

Also note in the Pickup/Drop off zone, drivers must stay in their car and move forward whenever practicable.

Although our staff do supervise children at the crossing, (as well as those who catch the bus), it is the responsibility of the parents to supervise their child/ren once they leave the school grounds. We strongly encourage parents of younger students to come inside the school grounds to collect them. Outside the Community Room is an ideal place to wait.
